Student Donation Drive for Service Hours

How to do a Donation Drive for Service Hours:

1. Ask permission from your parents.
2. Print out the [Donation Drive for Students Registration Form](#).
3. Print out the [Donation Drive Log](#) to help you keep track of the tasks you perform.
4. Decide which items you would like to collect (see [Hours Earned for Donated Items](#) for a list of items needed).
5. Decide when, where, and from whom you will ask for donations.
6. Make fliers and posters advertising your donation collection.
7. Ask people to donate needed items - advertise at school, church or temple, ask your friends, family, neighbors, local businesses, etc. Be sure to log all of your activity!
8. When your donation collection is over, count and write the tally on the [Donation Drive Log](#).
9. Fill out the [Community Service Project Reflection Questions](#) in this packet. Then ask a parent to call or email the coordinator (954-266-6822, esteehler@hsbroward.com) to arrange a time and date to drop off your donations. Drop-offs are usually scheduled on weekdays after school or in the early evening. You will bring your completed paperwork with you at the drop off. After all paperwork and donations are verified as received, a Letter of Documentation will be mailed or emailed (you decide) to you within 10 business days of the drop-off.

Item	Amount of Items	Equal
Paper towels	6 rolls	1 hour
Hand sanitizer	8 bottles (8oz. or larger)	1 hour
Dog treats (<u>soft treats, like Pup-peroni</u>)	2- 10oz. bags or 1- 25oz. bag	1 hour
White Copy Paper	3 reams (packs of 500 sheets)	1 hour
Nylabones or antler chews	2 medium/large size	1 hour
Catnip	Large canister	1 hour
Disinfecting wipes	3 canisters (of at least 75 count each)	1 hour
Pill Pockets (treat)	2 bags	1 hour
Training pee-pee pads	2 packs (at least 12 count)	1 hour
Heating Pads	1 Large (for post-surgery)	2 hours
Plastic Hard-sided pet carriers (NO soft sided)	1 carrier	3 hours
Corrugated cat scratcher (small)	2 cat scratchers	1 hour
Cat treats	4 small pouches or 1 large container	1 hour
Cat toys	8 toys	1 hour
Dog toys	2 large toys or 3 small toys	1 hour



Other needed items may be acceptable at the discretion of the coordinator, but *please* try to stick to the above list.

PLEASE no sheets, pillows, dog beds, leashes, collars, used litter boxes, rugs, used cat trees, appliances, food bowls or food.
