Puppies have developmental stages during which time it is critical to teach good habits and prevent undesirable behaviors. Exposure to other dogs and people during these stages will help your puppy develop into a calm, well-adjusted adult dog. Don't delay—this class is only for puppies 8 to 18 weeks old!

The four-week course is \$120 for puppies adopted from the shelter and \$150 for all other puppies. Class is held Saturdays from 9 to 10 AM. You can join this class at any time.

All you need is:

- A. Your registration and release forms
- B. Proof of vaccinations*
- C. Cash or check made out to HSBC
- D. Your puppy's bed
- E. Plenty of high-quality soft treats
- F. A 6-foot nylon leash (no retractable leashes or choke collars, please!)
- G. Your puppy!

* In an effort to keep all the animals healthy, you must show proof of vaccinations at the <u>first</u> class, and your puppy must have been in your home for <u>at least 10 days</u> prior to his first class or <u>you will be turned away</u>. (Each puppy must have his or her **second booster shot** before attending class!)

Please do not bring small children to class, and try to limit the number of family members to two. Please note that there are no refunds after the first class.
